Cohort Profile

49 Children – 22 (45%) Girls 27 (55%) boys

43 children - 88% of cohort have English as an Additional Language (EAL)

10 children – 20% have Special Educational Needs (SEN)

2 children – 4% were new to the country (arrived in 2016/2017)
