

Year 1 Phonics Summary 2016-2017

Cohort Summary

57 Children – 39 Girls (68%) 18 Boys (32%)

49 children – 86% of cohort have English as an Additional Language (EAL)

4 children – 7% of cohort have Special Educational Needs (SEN)

45 children – 79% of pupils are entitled to Pupil Premium (PP)

5 children - 9% of the cohort were new to country in 2016/2017

- 70% of year one pupils achieved the expected standard (increases to 77% with 5 dis-applied for being new to country)
- 74% of girls achieved the expected standard compared with 61% of boys (81% girls / 69% boys with 3F and 2M dis-applied)
- 71% of EAL children achieved the expected standard compared with 67% of non-EAL (77% EAL / 67% Non EAL with 5 diss)
- 75 % of SEN children achieved the expected standard compared with 69% of non-SEN (75% SEN / 77% with 5 dis-applied)
- 74% of pupil premium children achieved the expected standard compared with 60% of non-pupil premium (79% PP / 67% Non PP)

- Of the 17 children who did not pass the check:
 - 11 were females
 - 6 were males
 - 14 were EAL
 - 1 was just EAL, 1 EAL and new in Yr1, 3 EAL and new to country, 1 EAL, SEN and PP, 6 EAL and PP, 2 EAL and new to country
 - 11 were pupil premium
 - 1 was just PP, 1 PP and PA, 6 EAL and PP, 1 PP, EAL and SEN, 2 PP, EAL and new to country
 - 1 was SEN
 - 1 SEN, EAL and PP.
