

Parent Survey December 2020.

Many thanks to those who completed this survey. Although numbers completing were low we were encouraged by the many positive responses, and have taken on board some of the neutral and negative feedback in order to improve things for the Spring term.

39 responses out of whole school- paper copies sent home December so responses may be informed by Summer term full lockdown as well as Autumn term experience.

1 response = 3%- (rounded up) some left unanswered, therefore % may not equal 100.

Do you feel that the school has adopted adequate safety measures to keep children and adults safe in response to Covid -19?	85%	15%

Has distance learning/online learning tasks – provided by school - been sufficient for your child either during lockdown or periods of bubble closures?	72%	15%	8%
Has it been easy for you to contact the school during this period when the need has arisen?	72%	10%	8%
Are your children happy being back in school?	85%	10%	3%
<u>Comments:</u> Very few parents wrote comments, apart from general positive ‘thank you and well done!’ Some comments relating to things the Government need to address- not us, generally about lockdown! Some concern about other parents not following the rules Some concern about parking/ roadworks One person felt very disengaged and felt the phone call home instead of parent’s afternoon was rushed and impersonal. Following this last comment in particular we have made weekly phone calls available during this latest lockdown, and live zoom meetings for pupils to see their friends. (Not live lessons)
